Automated Student and Adult Learner Follow-Up System (ASALFS) Initial Matching Outcomes

The ASALFS initial matching process includes matches with the Texas Workforce Commission Unemployment Insurance database and the Coordinating Board student enrollment records.

Unduplicated Graduates Count of the individuals who have received awards under the Program Name, as reported on the Fall CBM009 (data for academic year). Each Individual is counted once, no matter how many awards have been received. Some social security numbers have been edited out of the initial count sent for processing, including those with leading zeros or alpha characters. Therefore, this count will not match the number of graduates as reported on the CBM009.

CBM001/00A Correctional Adjustments/Excluded from Graduate Cohort

Number of correctional students excluded from the Unduplicated Graduate cohort. Students were identified with a Remote Location code of "5" on the CBM001 or CBM00A.

Adjustments Number of students found in other databases, including Department of Defense, Federal Civil Service, and U.S. Postal Service. This match takes place after initial ASALFS matches.

CB 116 Supplemental Follow-Up Adjustments

Excluded from Graduate Cohort Students reported by the college as incarcerated or deceased.

Additional Success Students reported by the college as employed, self-employed, pursuing additional education, or volunteers in their field of study.
